College of Teacher Education on 24th Feb. 1993, by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India. The college is permanently affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University and is recognized by UGC in May 1991 under 2(F) & 12 (B) and also recognized by NCTE in May, 2015
