Introduction

Situated at the foothills of the majestic Dhauladhars, Government College of Teacher Education (GCTE) Dharamshala, a premiere educational institute of the region, was established in September, 1956 by the Government to meet the ever-growing demand of trained teachers. The college has since then been catering to the educational needs of Pre-service and In-service teachers. It was upgraded from Government College of Education to Government College of Teacher Education by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India on 24th February, 1993.

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has re-accredited this institution with 'B' Grade in the second cycle (May, 2015) with CGPA of 2.65. In 2023 the college was again reaccredited for the third cycle by NAAC and was awarded "B++" Grade. The college caters to Pre-service and In-service Teacher Trainings by conducting Induction Programmes, Teacher Training and Capacity Building Programmes, Seminars and Workshops, for In-service Teachers and Heads of Educational Institutions of six districts (Chamba, Kangra, Hamirpur, Mandi, Kullu and Lahaul & Spiti) of H.P. Various committees and cells have been established in the college for addressing the needs of the learner's viz. Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell, Women Grievance Redressal Cell, Career Guidance-Counseling and Placement Cell etc. Extensive theoretical orientation supplemented with five months teaching practice/internship provides a healthy learning environment for the holistic and harmonious development of the prospective teachers. The Government College of Teacher Education, Dharamshala is permanently affiliated to HP University, (HPU) Shimla recognised from National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi.

Teaching and Learning

Govt. College of Teacher Education, Dharamshala has established a set of intricate procedures and policies for maintaining and utilising physical, academic and support facilities i.e. laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc. Multiple mode approach for teaching-learning is adopted by teachers, which includes lecture cum discussion methods, technology based teaching and experiential learning both in theory papers and through the use of different laboratories as well as providing real life experiences to the students prior to and during School Internship Phases I & II.

A teaching schedule/academic calendar is a planned document developed by the faculty members of the institution through discussions and deliberations with different stakeholders.

The college has an effective assessment mechanism to evaluate the performance of students on various assessment tasks and enrich different curriculum practices as per the needs of learners.

Following curriculum enrichment practices are adopted by the institution.

1. Morning Assembly
2. Class Tests
3. Assignments/Projects/Surveys
4. Mid Term Tests
5. Culture, Sports, Co-curricular, Extension and Outreach Activities
6. Micro Teaching and Simulation
7. Internship Phase (I and II)

Internal Assessment Mechanism

Internal Evaluation/Continuous Comprehensive Assessment is an integral component of B.Ed. Course. In theory Paper, 20% of the total marks are meant for Internal Assessment. No student has failed in internal assessment during the academic session 2023-24.

Mid Term Tests/Class Tests: Mid Term Tests are conducted by the Examination Committee after completion of nearly fifty percent of the syllabus in each semester. Class tests are taken by the teacher educators, evaluated and appropriate immediate feedback is provided to the students for improving their performance.

Prompt communication of Assessment/Results to students

The internal assessment is submitted to the affiliating university well in time through online mode as per the direction received from the controller of examinations. Component-wise internal assessment is prepared after proper evaluation of different assignments/activities by the teacher educators. House Examination results are communicated and discussed with students for the purpose of immediate feedback. Final university results are displayed on institutional website. There are different registers maintained by the examination committee and students can consult them as per their requirements.

School Internship Programme (2022-24)

Co-ordinator: Dr. Atul Acharya

The Internship Programme for the B. Ed. Two year programme is divided into 2 phases (First phase: 4 weeks & Second phase: 16 weeks). Before going to Internship Schools, student-teachers attended Microteaching and Simulation classes in Semester-II and Semester-III. A total of 17 internship schools were earmarked for the programme. The first phase of the Internship started from 01-05-2023 and successfully culminated on 28-05-2024.

The second phase started from 04-09-2024 and rounded off on 30-12-2023.

Student-teachers of the college took active part in all kinds of activities that took place in the Internship Schools. They also carried out a One week community engagement drive during the School Internship Programme where they carried out various activities like Cleanliness drive, awareness programmes in the vicinity of the internship schools.

A total of 233 students successfully completed the School Internship Programme (2022-24) in the Final Teaching Practice Examination that was conducted by SPU Mandi from 06-02-2024 to 09-02-2024.

Feedback

Feedback collection, analysis, and action are integral to the institution's operations. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) gathers feedback from teacher trainees on their academic satisfaction and campus experiences through a 20 item Proforma titled "Overall Appraisal of the College by the Students". Counselling and Admission Process

Admission to fill up the seats was conducted through Entrance Test/Merit by the affiliating university, followed by Central Counselling conducted by the Department of Education. Students were invited for online counselling, and respective colleges were allotted to them according to merit and students' preferences by the University. Communication was done through University and college websites, as well as print media (newspapers, etc.).

The number of seats for admission to the two-year program was two hundred and fifty (250), i.e., 5 units of 50 student-teachers each, which was approved by NCTE, inclusive of 10 seats for in-

service teachers of the Department of Education, Government of Himachal Pradesh.

2. Non- Medical, two units comprising 100 students.
3. Arts/ Commerce, two units comprising 100 students.

Health sensitization/ Gender Equity

Mentor - Mentee Groups

Immediately after admissions, students are assigned one of four houses: Mahatma Gandhi House, Tagore House, Kalam House, and Vivekanand House. Each house comprises approximately of 62 students. Four teachers are designated as the in-charges for each house. Students can seek assistance from their respective house in-charges at any time. These in-

charges also serve as mentors for the students in their house. Mentor-mentee meetings are held regularly before each house-based activity to ensure guidance and support.

Capacity Building of Students

In alignment with the subject "Atma Bodh" for the fourth session of trainee teachers, an eight-day "Special Lecture Series" was organized under the direction of Principal Prof. Aarti Verma and coordination of Dr. Charu Sharma from April 1, 2024, to April 9, 2024. Each day, subject experts provided the trainee teachers with theoretical knowledge as well as activity-based practical experiences.
